RESOURCES OFFERED

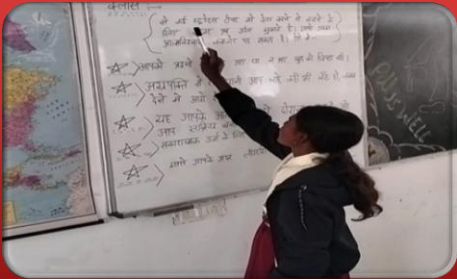

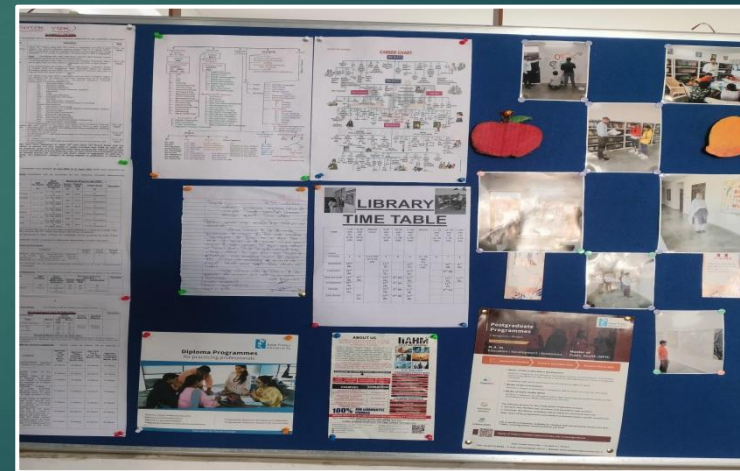
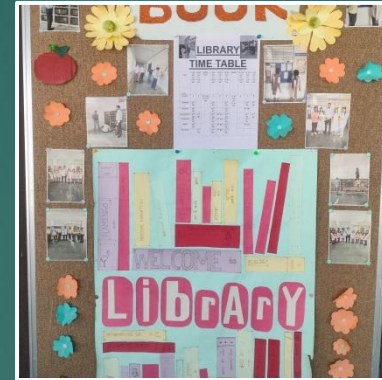


Organizing Book Introduction Sessions
